Legend

The time is local siderial time. The dates are eastern time zone dates and the number on the far right is the local sideral date. The dark vertically slanted line marks midnight eastern time and the light vertically slanted line marks 8am eastern time.

The ~ mark indicates that the telescope has not yet been scheduled.

GBT proposal codes on the graphics schedule have been shortened to their minimum unique length. For example a code of 1A7 is GBT01A-007 while 2B45 would be GBT02B-045. The first number in the shortened code is the year after 2000, the letter represents the trimester (A, B or C) and the last number is a number between 1 and 999.

The siderial time at midnight on the first is 23h24m.
